M.A. in Education, Literacy Online**

This program is designed to give you the skills to serve as a reading specialist in any K-12 grade level. In this degree program, you will learn to provide direct reading intervention work with students, select and adapt reading instruction materials and plan and conduct reading staff development. You will gain the necessary knowledge to develop and coordinate reading programs at the school, district or county level. This program is TEACH Grant eligible for up to \$7,448.**

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Admission Requirements

M.A. in Education, Educational Administration

- Bachelor's degree
- Basic credential
- Application for the Master of Arts in Education
- Two letters of recommendation from individuals familiar with the candidate's work in the field of education
- Statement of Purpose describing the candidate's interest in pursuing the degree
- Employment verification of three years teaching experience
- A minimum undergraduate grade point average of 2.5
- Official transcripts mailed directly to the Office of Admissions from each college or university attended.

All materials will be evaluated to assess an applicant's qualifications for admission; however, no one indicator shall determine acceptance of an applicant.

M.A. in Education, Literacy

- Bachelor's degree
- A minimum undergraduate grade point average of 2.5
- Teaching credential or equivalent experience
- Statement of Purpose – a typed, double-spaced, one-to-two page statement that talks about you and why you wish to pursue a master's degree in education. Things you might include are: your goals, ideals, experiences, special skills, community service.
- Two letters of recommendation from individuals familiar with your work in the field of education
- Three years of full time teaching experience are required prior to recommendation for the California Reading and Literacy Added Authorization and the California Reading and Literacy Leadership Specialist credentials[†]
